Oswego Junior Woman's Club (OJWC) is a subsidiary of the General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC). GFWC is one of the world's largest and oldest women's volunteer service organizations and has approximately 8,000 members in the United States. Members of GFWC support the arts, preserve natural resources, promote education in various sectors, encourage healthy lifestyles, stress civic involvement, and work toward world peace and understanding. OJWC was chartered in 2012 and, at that time, began its commitment to volunteering and service in Oswego, Illinois, and the surrounding communities.

The Oswego Junior Woman's Club mission is dedicated to community improvement by enhancing the lives of others through volunteer services.

OJWC recognizes the importance and value of being involved in the community in which one lives while understanding that opportunities may not always arise given one's financial situation. To honor the contribution of a student who believes in community involvement but has taken on additional responsibilities due to a family's financial need, OJWC will recognize two students from each Oswego high school (OHS and OEHS) by awarding a \$1,000 scholarship to a qualified, college-bound high school senior. The secondary school can be a college, university, junior college, trade or technical school.

Scholarship recipients will be chosen based on the student's financial need and involvement and active participation in bettering the lives of their family, themselves and community.

Selection Criteria:

- Must be an Oswego high school (OHS, OEHS) senior student
- (1) Letter of recommendation from a service organization, employer, instructor or coach in which you have been affiliated with for more than 6 months
 - Your letter of recommendation cannot be from an Oswego Junior Woman's Club member
- Maintained at least a B grade point average throughout high school career
- Completed application form, including short written statements about your current financial situation, future goals, the value of community service and the value and importance the scholarship would bring to your current financial situation.

- We appreciate and respect each family's privacy. Information regarding the amount of family household income is not a judging requirement, and we ask you refrain from listing this information.
- Statements including the mention of a parent losing a job, or the additional responsibility of becoming a caretaker for a family member, a terminal illness etc. suffices as defining a "financial need".
